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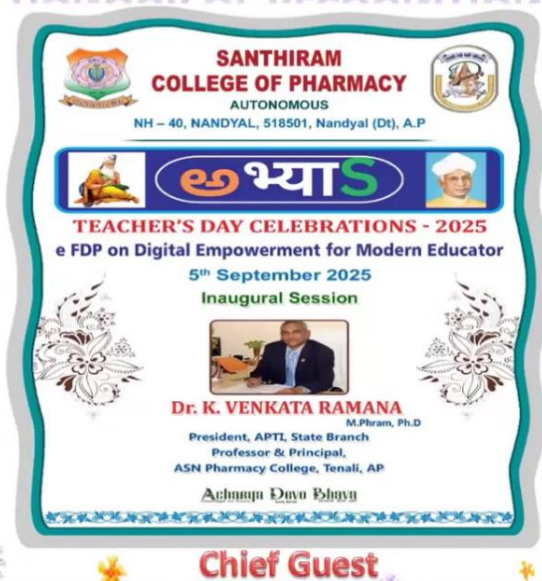

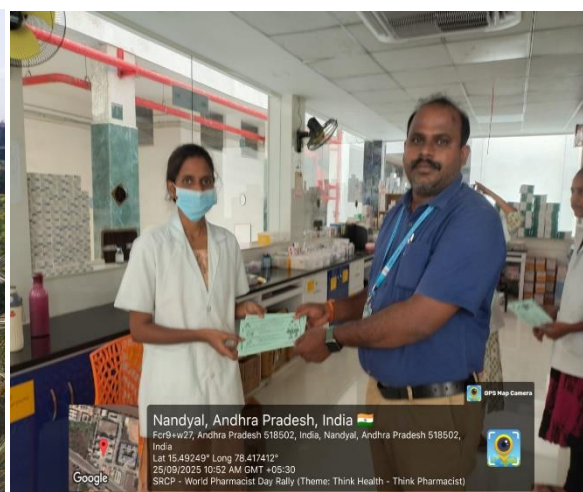
profession. Their inspiring addresses motivated students to uphold ethical and professional standards in pharmacy practice.
